Club President John Skowron called the meeting to order. He told the membership it was a good year for the Club, despite some weather cancellations and scheduling issues with the Guard.

There was a motion to have John S. talk to the Sgt about scheduling medical. Jane G. will also check with EMS agencies in Granville and surrounding counties to see if contract medics are available.

With Ryan Eastman in Texas and Gary returning to school, we need someone to be a backup for website maintenance. Peter L. suggested we return to a simpler format for updates and not the coding that has been done. This might make it easier for others to assist in updates. Jeff Rorer volunteered to assist with website maintenance.

Members requested that the Club go back to the 5 year membership renewals with a small discount for that option.
