

NSSC RULES/SAFETY BRIEF

GENERAL RANGE RULES:

- ALL COMMANDS WILL COME FROM THE CENTER OF THE LINE.
- ALL PERSONNEL ON THE RANGE ARE SAFETY OFFICERS; ANYONE OBSERVING AN UNSAFE CONDITION CAN CALL A CEASE FIRE.
- ALL PERSONNEL ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALERTING THE CENTER OF THE LINE WITH ANY SAFETY CONCERNS.
- RANGE OPERATIONS WILL BE IN ACCORDANCE W/NRA HIGH POWER RIFLE RULES.
- ONLY RIFLES AUTHORIZED BY NRA HIGHPOWER RIFLE, UNDER RULE 3 ARE ALLOWED.
- NO FULLY AUTOMATIC OR SUPPRESSED RIFLES ARE ALLOWED, NO MUZZLE BRAKES ARE ALLOWED.
- INDIVIDUALS UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL OR ILLEGAL DRUGS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON THE RANGE.
- NOTIFY THE CENTER OF THE LINE IN CASE OF A MEDICAL EMERGENCY. THE MATCH DIRECTOR WILL CALL BUTNER PUBLIC SAFETY FOR ASSISTANCE (919) 575-6561 extension 0.
- PARKING IS NOT ALLOWED ON THE 1000 YD FIRING LINE OR ON THE GRASS.
- ANYONE WHO DISREGARDS THESE RANGE OR SAFETY RULES WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE RANGE.
- **This is a family-oriented range, no offensive language will be tolerated either verbally or on the scorecards. Per NRA rules, violators are subject to DQ and removal from the range.**

SAFETY RULES:

- ALWAYS KEEP RIFLES POINTED IN A SAFE DIRECTION, ALWAYS MAINTAIN MUZZLE AWARENESS.
- EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATORS WILL BE REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES ON THE RANGE.
- KEEP RIFLES CASED, BAGGED OR ON YOUR GEAR UNTIL YOU ARE GIVEN PERMISSION BY THE CENTER OF THE LINE TO HANDLE YOUR RIFLE.
- YOU MAY REMOVE YOUR EIC ONLY AFTER YOU HAVE TAKEN YOUR POSITION ON THE FIRING LINE AND YOU ARE GIVEN PERMISSION BY THE CENTER OF THE LINE TO HANDLE YOUR RIFLE.(THREE MINUTE PREP TIME BEGINS)
- DO NOT LOAD YOUR RIFLE UNTIL THE COMMAND TO LOAD IS GIVEN. LOAD DURING RAPID-FIRE ONCE YOUR TARGET APPEARS.
- LOADED RIFLES WILL BE POINTED DOWN RANGE AT ALL TIMES.
- KEEP YOUR FINGER OFF THE TRIGGER UNTIL YOU ARE READY TO FIRE.
- UPON THE COMMAND "CEASE FIRE" ALL RIFLES WILL BE UNLOADED, ACTIONS OPENED, MAGAZINES REMOVED AND ECI'S INSERTED. AFTER RAPID-FIRE, REMAIN ON THE FIRING LINE UNTIL THE LINE IS CLEARED BY THE CENTER OF THE LINE.
- SCOREKEEPERS WATCH YOUR SHOOTERS WHILE THEY ARE ON THE FIRING LINE. CHECK YOUR SHOOTERS ONCE FIRING HAS CEASED.
- DO NOT GO FORWARD OF THE FIRING LINE OR MOVE DOWN RANGE UNTIL PERMISSION HAS BEEN GIVEN BY THE CENTER OF THE LINE.
- IN THE PITS YOU MUST REMAIN ON THE CONCRETE PAD DURING ALL FIRING.

NOTES: REMEMBER, WE ARE GUESTS OF CAMP BUTNER AND HAVE BEEN GRANTED PERMISSION TO USE THIS FACILITY.

POLICE THE ENTIRE FIRING LINE, PIT AND BUNKER AREAS, ALWAYS LEAVE THE RANGE IN BETTER CONDITION THAN YOU FOUND IT.

FIND ANY NEW SHOOTERS ON THE LINE AND WELCOME THEM. APPOINT ADJACENT EXPERIENCED SHOOTERS TO KEEP EYE ON/HELP THEM.
