Team Requirements

Team members must meet all of the following conditions:

- Be an active member of the North State Shooting Club
- Be an active member of the National Rifle Association
- Be an active member of their respective state rifle and pistol association
- Be able to attend as many team events as possible
- Be an active and productive member of the team

Rifle Requirements

Team Members Must Own or Posses a rifle as follows:

- At least one legitimate National Match Service Rifle or NRA Match Rifle*
½ MOA or ¼ MOA National Match/Match Rifle Sights

* All AR-15 type rifles in .223/5.56 must have a barrel twist rate of 1:8" or faster.

Preferred Credentials

The following credentials are preferred but not required:

- Master or High Master Card
- Distinguished Rifleman Badge
- President's Hundred
- At least one year of shooting at Camp Perry
- Previous team shooting experience
