

NCRPA HIGH POWER RIFLE CLINIC 2007



The NCRPA High Power Rifle. M1 Garand clinic will be on April 21, 2007. The clinic will be held at the North Carolina National Guard Training Site in Butner, NC on **Range #4**. There are green signs that show the way to the training site. The clinic is hosted by the North Carolina Highpower Rifle Team. On Sunday, April 22, 2007, there will be a match that is open to anyone and any type of rifle, and there will be special Garand categories so we encourage clinic participants to come back on Sunday and re-enforce the skills they learned on Saturday.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Bring your own food and drinks. None will be available on the range. You may wish to bring a stool or chair for the seminar portion. On arriving at the range, you may drive your vehicle to the pit area.

Participants may use their own ammunition if preferred. Ammunition issued will be .30 cal. (30-06) M-2 Ball. Ammo will not be issued for Sundays match but will be available for sale.

Shooting stools, coats, mats, spotting scopes, etc. are not necessary, but would be nice if you have them.

Participants are required to operate targets and police the range and pits upon completion of firing.

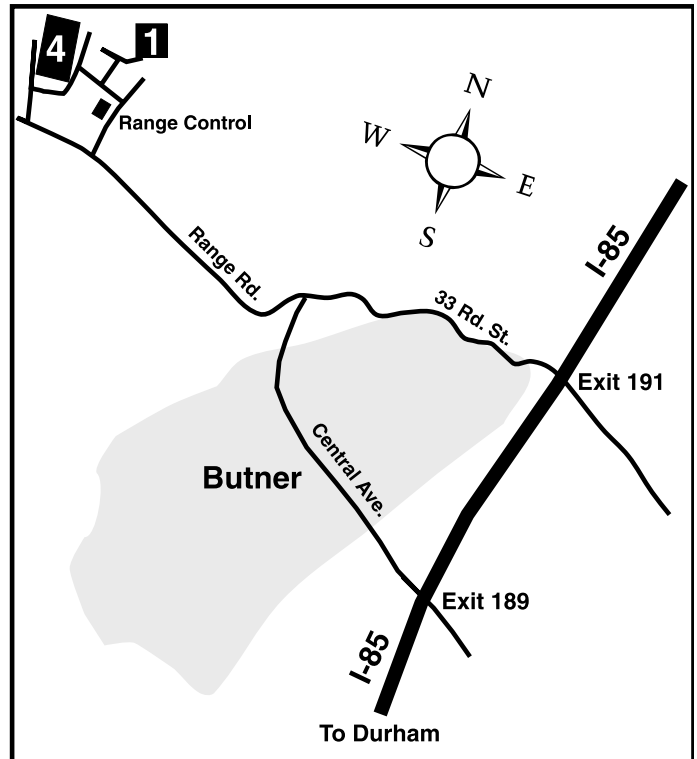
On arrival at the clinic, report to the statistical office in the pits to confirm squadding.

While membership in the NRA and NCPRA is not required, it is strongly encouraged.

The proceeds of the clinic are used to run the state shooting teams. Expenses include the cost of participation in the National Matches, rifle maintenance, ammunition, junior equipment and expenses, etc.

MATCH INFORMATION

Sunday's match is open to anyone that wishes to participate. The match will be held at the 200 yd. line and will be conducted like a Garand Match starting with prone slow fire, prone rapid fire, sitting rapid fire and ending with standing slow fire.



CLINIC SCHEDULE:

8:00 AM Registration

8:30 AM Clinic begins with a classwork session which will consist of safety, basic positions, operation of the M-1, range commands and target operation. The class will include subjects such as care and cleaning, reloading for competition, equipment, and use of the Data Book.

11:00 AM Firing range. Relays one and two on the line, relays three and four in the pits. Participants will fire sighters, record zeros and fire 20 shots prone slow fire 10 shots Prone Rapid Fire, 10 Shots Sitting Rapid fire, 10 Shots Standing Slow Fire. There will then be a pit change and relays three and four will fire while one and two pull targets.

The clinic should be over by approximately 4:00 PM. there will then be a session explaining the North Carolina Civilian Marksmanship Program and the M-1 sales program.

All rifles and ammunition are furnished by the CMP. Members of the North Carolina Rifle Team will instruct and coach. Fees are \$50.00 per day for adults and \$25.00 for Juniors. (Juniors are eligible up to their 20th birthday.) Clinic will be held at Range 4 on the National Guard Training Center, Butner, NC.

Brass will become the property of the person participating in the clinic. Clips will be retained for future use.

The clinic will be held on Saturday, April 21, 2007. An open rifle Match with Special Garand Categories on Sunday, April 22, 2007. The match is open to anyone, but we especially encourage clinic participants to come back on Sunday and re-enforce the skills they learned on Saturday.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Early registration is encouraged since the clinic is likely to fill up.
2. Bring your own food and drinks. None will be available on the range. You may wish to bring a stool or chair for the seminar portion. On arriving at the range, bring equipment with you to the pits. You may not have time to return to your vehicle.
3. Participants may use their own ammunition if preferred. Ammunition issued will be .30 cal. (30-06) M-2 Ball. Ammo will not be issued for Sundays match but will be available for sale.
4. Shooting stools, coats, mats, spotting scopes, etc. are not necessary, but would be nice if you have them.

5. Participants are required to operate targets and police the range and pits upon completion of firing.
6. On arrival at the clinic, report to the statistical office in the pits to confirm squadding.
7. While membership in the NRA and NCPRA is not required, it is strongly encouraged.
